

FY23 SABG Funding Allocations


Funding distribution among Idaho Behavioral Health Regions

Authorization for EFT/W-9 Forms

If you are a grantee that has not previously received payment from the State of Idaho.



Background Checks

For all staff that will implement direct services with youth and/or vulnerable adults.



CPS & PPS Credentials

Certified Prevention Specialist (CPS)

- If you are a grantee with two consecutive years of SABG funding, provide proof of your CPS status or efforts toward obtaining a CPS.
 - Scan of CPS Certificate
 - Written demonstration of efforts to obtain CPS credentials, highlighting recently completed and planned training opportunities to earn educational hours.

Provisional Prevention Specialist (PPS)

- If you are a new grantee or have not been funded consecutively in the past two years, you have 120 days (until October 31, 2022) to obtain a PPS credential.
- The PPS credential requires the completion of two short courses on ODP's free Learning Management System.
 - 1. Substance Abuse Prevention Ethics
 - 2. Fundamentals of Prevention


