

Using the Learning Management System (LMS)

1. To register for the LMS, go to https://odplms.tovuti.io/ and click on the "Register" button in the navigation bar.



- 2. On the next page, choose your registration type (General or Grantee) and click the "*Register*" button.
 - 1. If your organization is a current recipient of the PFS or SABG funds, use the "Grantee Registration" option. All others will use the "General Registration" option.



 Next, complete the General Registration form to create your account, then click the *"Register"* button. The registration page will redirect you to the Learner Dashboard.
