

Funding Description

- The purpose of the funding is to support substance use and misuse primary prevention efforts at both state and local levels and empower organizations and communities to identify and implement solutions to specific drug and alcohol-related problems that are experienced locally.
- Primary prevention programs and strategies are directed at individuals not identified as in need
 of treatment and involve activities that shift focus 'upstream' to educate and support individuals
 and communities to prevent drug and alcohol misuse and the development of substance use
 disorders.
- The expected outcomes of funded programming include:
 - 1. Create, maintain, or expand a comprehensive system of prevention services that are community-driven, strategically focused, evidence-based, and culturally relevant to Idaho's individuals, families and communities;
 - 2. Delay the initiation of substance use and/or prevent substance misuse behaviors and the development of substance use disorders to ultimately reduce the incidence of alcohol, tobacco, and other drug misuse-related problems.



Eligible Funding Requests

Eligible applications will propose efforts and activities that are either focused on the implementation of evidence-based programs and practices (EBPs) and/or integrate an EBP into activities in some capacity. Types of primary prevention strategies and activities that will be funded through this grant award:

- 1. Direct service evidence-based prevention programming for parents, families, and caregivers;
- 2. Direct service evidence-based prevention programming for youth and young adults;
- 3. Direct service, evidence-based prevention programming for high-risk and/or identified priority populations, including: Hispanic/Latino, Native American, Veteran, and Seniors (age 65+) populations;
- 4. Community-based policy and environmental prevention strategies designed to reduce the impact of substance use and misuse at the community-level with the general population and or/an identified high-need or priority population.

Applicants may request funding for up to 5 different programs or activities in the application. The number of programs an applicant requests funding for will not impact the likelihood of being awarded funds.



Eligible Applicants

Eligible applicants include public and governmental entities (including tribal entities), such as counties, cities, schools and school districts, and local law enforcement agencies; as well as non-profit entities such as youth or community-serving organizations and community coalitions.

Federal regulations (Section 90.135, HHS) prohibit the awarding of Block Grant funds to any entity other than a public or non-profit entity.

- 2. Community Needs Assessment 20 points total
- 3. Capacity Building 15 points total
- 4. Program Planning, Implementation, and Budget 80 points
- 5. Evaluation 15 points
- 6. Sustainability & Cultural Competence 10 points




Application Tips

- Entire Application:
 - Fully answer/address questions and prompts
 - Have a someone proofread your application
- Community Needs Assessment:
 - Fully answer/address questions and prompts
 - Use relevant, timely data
- Program Planning, Implementation, & Budget:
 - Select the correct Prevention Strategy & IOM Category
 - Clearly explain why the chosen program/activity is the best fit for your community needs and population
 - Clearly outline the action plan to implement the proposed projects
 - Provide detailed budget justifications
- Evaluation: Clearly outline your evaluation plan, include outcome data from past programs if available
- Sustainability & Cultural Competence: Think bigger than the bare minimum
