

Purpose



No other state survey provides **local** data



Participation gives access to state comparisons



Items are **actionable** for program planning

Survey Features



Superintendents can pick any day between September 20th and December 15th to administer



Superintendents will designate **Survey Coordinators** to work with Bach Harrison during administration



The survey is free of charge



District-level data will **only be shared** with those identified by the Superintendent



The survey can be completed in **30 minutes (online)** to **40 minutes (paper/pencil)**



Last day to register is September 15th

Sampling

Any **public**, **private and charter** schools may participate

Census

Survey all students in grades 6, 8, 10, and 12

Most districts will use a census

Best option for districts with fewer than 600 students per grade, or for districts who would like to receive highquality school-level data


District Sample

Survey a selection of schools or students in a district

Appropriate only for districts with more than 600 students per grade

BH will work with Survey Coordinators to identify the best way to develop this narrow school-district-level sample

Administration: Three Options



District Responsibilities

Designate one Survey Coordinator contact

- Survey Coordinator responsibilities:
 - 1. Receive all print materials to aid in administration
 - (i.e., paper forms and envelopes (if paper administration), scripts, parental consents, etc.)
 - 2. Confirm survey dates

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- 3. Establish a process for surveying students in each school
- 4. Prepare teachers/proctors for the survey
- 5. Establish a parental consent process
- 6. Assemble survey packets (if paper administration)

OR

Distribute survey web links (if online administration)


7. Send and paper surveys (if paper administration)

2019 Survey Results

2019 IHYS Results

The 2019 IHYS was administered to nearly <u>10,000 Idaho students at 82</u> <u>schools in 34 Districts.</u>

IHYS Student Participation Map







1 in 3 drank alcohol

1 in 3 used a vape pen or e-cigarette

1 in 5 used marijuana

Statewide results of 6th, 8th, 10th, and 12th graders found that:

- <u>37%</u> said it is easy to get alcohol
- <u>29%</u> said it is easy to get prescription drugs for misuse
- 25% said it is easy to get tobacco
- 24% said it is easy to get marijuana
