

## **PARTNERSHIPS FOR SUCCESS LAW ENFORCEMENT GRANT**

The Office of Drug Policy is pleased to announce the release of the Partnerships for Success Law Enforcement (PFS-LE) Grant.

### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this grant is to prevent **underage drinking**, **marijuana** use, and **methamphetamine** use in Idaho through effective law enforcement techniques including:

All law enforcement agencies including **tribal**, **local**, **state**, and **federal** are encouraged to apply.

### **FUNDING**

The due date for applications is **June 6, 2022 at 7:00am MST**. Applicants will be made aware of funding decisions on June 17, 2022. Funds will be available between July 1, 2022 and June 30, 2023. This 1-year grant opportunity will be made available annually until FY2023. Between **\$54,000** and **\$74,000** is available in each region. We intend to fund 2-3 agencies in each region of the state.

Funding will be provided on a **reimbursement** basis through an online form. Quarterly reporting and documentation required.

### **REPORTING**

Agencies will be asked to provide **online quarterly reports** that reflect selected activities including:

- Number of activities conducted (for all activities)
- Number of operations in which a person or organization failed to follow the law (for compliance checks or shoulder tap operations)
- Number of hours patrolling (for party patrols or interdiction activities)
- Number of underage drinking parties disbanded (for party patrols)
- Number of stops that resulted in drug seizures (for interdiction activities)
- Types of drugs seized (for interdiction activities)
- Amounts of drugs seized (for interdiction activities)

### **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS**

If awarded, one representative of the application will be required to participate in a one-hour **virtual training** to be held on **Thursday, July 7th** at 10:00am MST.

All staff time used for these activities must be **overtime** hours dedicated to prevention work, and all activities must be implemented within the applicant's respective jurisdiction.
