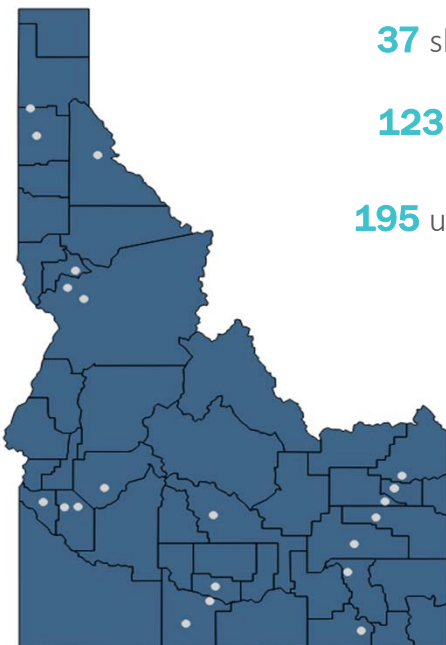


PFS: Law Enforcement Outcomes



The Partnership for Success Grant funds law enforcement (LE) agencies to prevent underage drinking, marijuana use, and methamphetamine use in Idaho through proven techniques including interdiction activities, party patrols, shoulder tap operations, compliance checks and community presentations. All staff time used for these activities was conducted during overtime hours.

Between December 2018 and January 2019 a total of **22** agencies conducted the following:



*Rexburg has 2 LE agencies

37 shoulder tap operations¹, with over **13%** resulting in citation.

123 compliance checks², with over **13%** resulting in citations to retailers.

195 underage drinking party patrols, patrolling more than **2501.25** hours and disbanding **87** underage drinking parties.

56 presentations related to prevention reaching approx. **4099** Idahoans.



471 Interdiction operations, patrolling more than **3425.5** hours. During that time, **105** stops were made and resulted in:



24.5 lbs. marijuana and **6.2 grams** of THC oil



3 grams of cocaine



9.4 lbs. of methamphetamine



22.8 grams of psychedelic mushrooms



7 prescription drugs



66 pieces of paraphernalia, **2**



93.9 grams of heroin

firearms, and **1 trap vehicle** to hide drugs.

1. Shoulder Taps: Underage decoy, supervised by an officer, approaches an adult going into an establishment to buy alcohol and asks the adult to purchase alcohol for them. If the attempt is successful, the provider is detained and dealt with appropriately.

2. Compliance Checks: Law enforcement officials supervise undercover youth who attempt to purchase alcohol; if the attempt is successful, the establishment is penalized.
