## RED RIBBON WEEK

Red Ribbon Week is the oldest and largest drug prevention campaign in the country. Formally designated as Red Ribbon Week in 1988, this annual event serves as a channel for communities and individuals to engage in drug education and prevention and make a personal commitment to a healthy and drug-free life. The theme of Red Ribbon Week for 2014 is "Love Yourself...Be Drug Free."

Red Ribbon Week grew out of the "Camarena Club Proclamation" which honored DEA special agent, [Enrique \(Kiki\) S. Camarena](#), who gave his life to fight drug trafficking. Parents and youth in communities across the U.S. began wearing red ribbons in his memory and as a symbol of their dedication to be drug free and raise awareness of the destruction caused by drug use.
